The Florida Certified Organic Growers and Consumers, Inc. (FOG) Materials Review Committee has reviewed your two products Superhume and Micro-Boost (formerly Micro-Plex). The committee has approved Superhume for use in organic production.

The committee has approved Micro-Boost for restricted use in organic production. The use of this product is limited to situations where micronutrient deficiencies of boron and molybdenum are present and documented by a soil analysis. This product should not be used in place of a soil building program that targets micronutrients.

These products will be included in the 1997 edition of the FOG Brands Names List. Recently, the Board of Directors of FOG have approved acceptance and has subscribed to the Organic Materials Review Institute (OMRI). For future product renewal we encourage manufactures to apply through the OMRI. Since your products have been reviewed and approved by FOG you will be charged the discounted renewal rate by the OMRI. In contrast to FOGs program the OMRI program will have national recognition. The OMRI will publish its first national brands list in spring of 1998 and we will accept all materials on this list for use by FOG certified growers. Further information on renewal is available upon request from our office.

Approval of this product is not an endorsement by FOG to growers. Approval means that the product meets the current standards approved by our organization. Our organization prohibits the use of this letter or the FOG name or seal to promote your products. Any questions or concerns should be made to our office.
